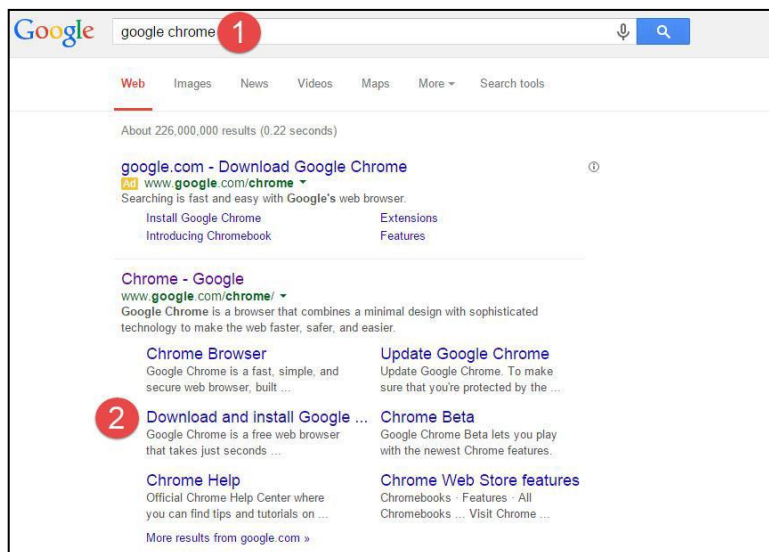
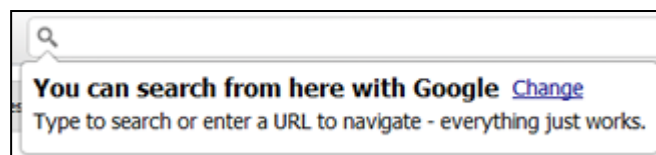


1. Go to **Google Search** and enter **Google Chrome**
2. Click on **Download** and **Install Google Chrome**



To install Chrome for your user account, follow these steps below. You may see the option to install the browser for all the user accounts on your computer in the process. If you don't see the option, you can learn how to install Chrome for multiple user accounts.

1. Download the installer file
2. If prompted, click "Run" or "Save".
3. If you have saved the installer, double-click the installer file to start the installation process. Your home page settings and browser history will automatically be imported from your default browser.
4. **Windows 7/Vista/XP** A Chrome window opens once everything is set up. The first time Chrome opens, you'll see a message letting you know that you can search with Google directly from the address bar (also known as the omnibox). If you'd like to change your default search engine, click **Change**.



Windows 8 A welcome dialog appears, click **Next** to select your default browser. If you select **Google Chrome**, it'll launch as a Windows 8 app from the Start Screen. Having trouble installing or opening Chrome? See troubleshooting information
